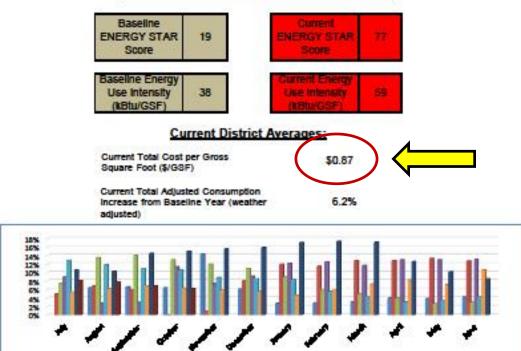

- 2 Baseline Information is based on data from Flacel Year (FY) 2010. With the exception of Holland EL, Goodnoe EL, and Churchville EL Whose baselines have been reset to FY 2015. Soil Felinstone EL's baseline has been updated to the 12 month period ending August 2015. Holland and Newtown Middle School have a baseline partial ending August 2019.
- 3 Wrightstown Elementary School will be added back to the performance with a baseline period ending 1/31/2020. This will need to be reset once a full operating year has been completed (8/31/2020) Due to Covid this will be pushed back a year to 8/31/2021.
- 4 Rolling Hills Elementary School is closed for renovation beginning June 2019. It will be excluded from performance beginning June 2019 August 2020\* ("New date of October 2020 due to COVID and State Interruptions of construction.) Due to a meter change-out there is a gap in information between 07/2019 and 10/2020. As a result, Aramark will not be including performance on this achool until a full year of operating date has been completed under the new meters. If the bill can be provided for the missing perfor we can resease inclusion.

- ✓ The project has been moved to 2023 to be teamed with the CC HVAC and Controls Replacement project
- ✓ The Foundation Drainage project requires the removal of the condensing units located around the perimeter of the building. Teaming with the HVAC project allows for the most effective phasing
- Moving to 2023 allows for the potential use of the former RMS for phasing (other work includes plaster repairs, floor maint. and emergency gen.)



HVAC equipment potentially impacted by foundation drainage project and planned for removal in 2023 with the HVAC/Controls Replacement project.

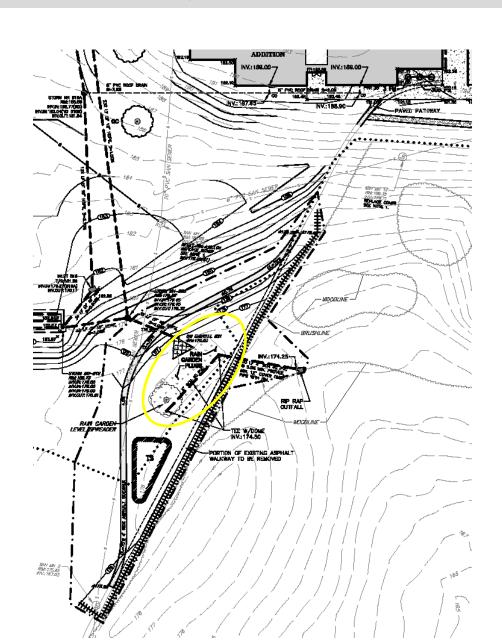

#### Holland Middle School Rain Garden Modifications - ADDED -

- ✓ The modifications have been in planning since June 2019
- ✓ Storm water is quickly filling rain garden and spills over paved sidewalk. Poor draining area of the site, few options
- ✓ Path used by students and community
- ✓ The Township and BCCD have approved changes required for final site approval and escrow release
- ✓ Path relocation, added storm water piping and plantings

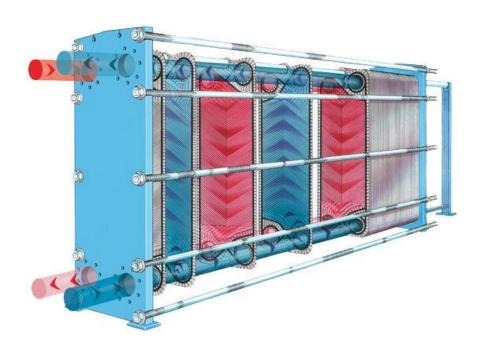

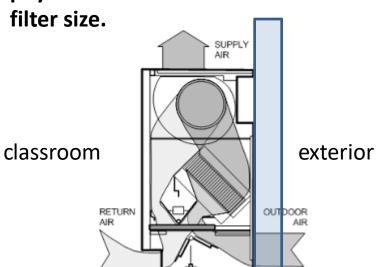

preferred filtration modification pending
the equipment motors are capable of
supporting, the impact to the air flow
doesn't compromise filtration and the
physical unit allows for the increased



□ Bipolar Ionization works by introducing positive and negative ions into the air. The ionization causes production of clusters of hydroxyl (OH) radicals, which are formed on the surface of microbes, removing hydrogen from the microbes' cell walls, thereby inactivating potentially infectious particles. This will be the alternative modification to the MERV 13 filter fit-out.

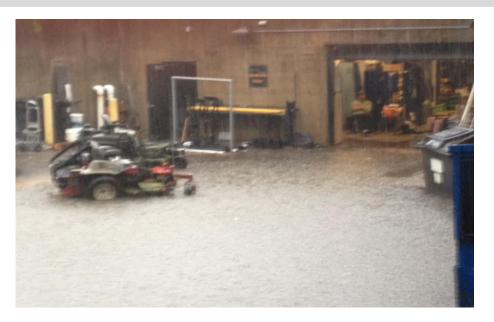

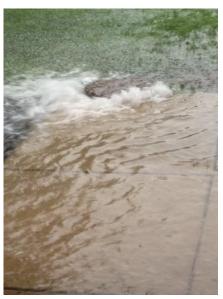

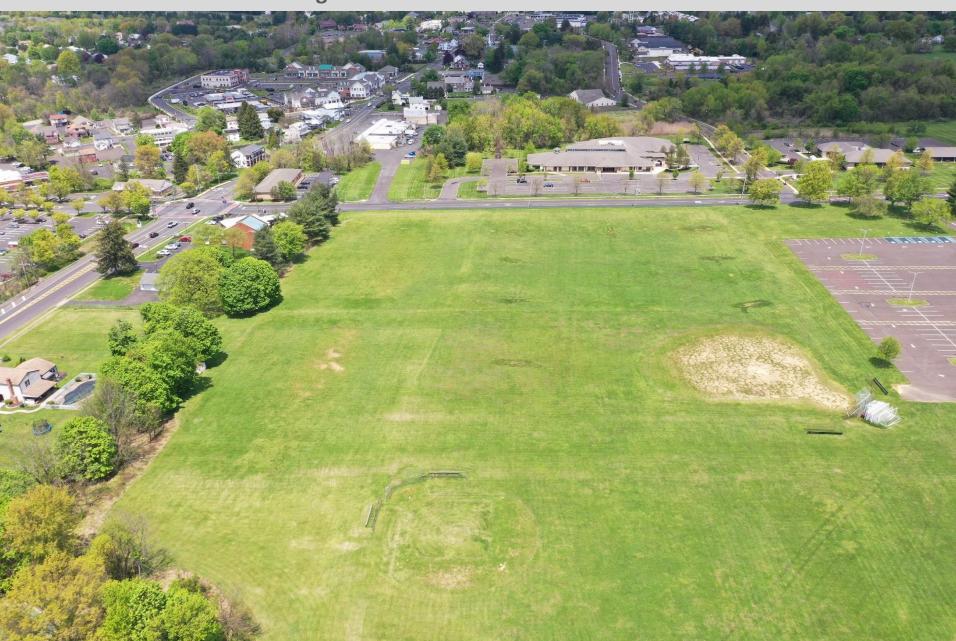
