Brightly Software – Event Manager Upgrade Amendment

- Previous approval was for Professional edition.
- Misunderstanding on edition to include outside user group access.
- Amend agreement to include Enterprise edition.
- Increase of \$13,807.76 over 3 years.
- Total Contract Value
 - o Professional \$56,779.60
 - Enterprise \$70,587.36



Sol Feinstone Library Packing and Moving

- Wayne Moving to pack and relocate library to Richboro Middle School storage area.
- August 2023 December 2023
- Eliminate the need for temporary power and heat.
- Library to be reopened January 2024.
- Not to Exceed: \$27,200
- Includes redelivery and unpacking of books in January.

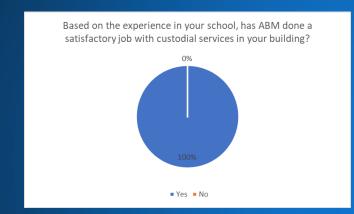


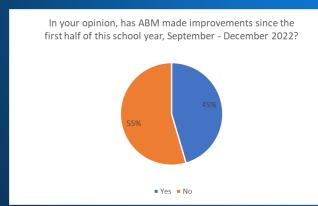
Rock Gold Softball License Agreement

- Year 1 \$5,000

- Year 5 \$5,800

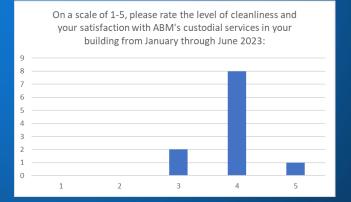


ABM End of School Survey Results

Propane Contract Extension

- Contract with Rhoads Energy set to expire at end of 2023/2024 school year
- Contract requires CRSD to purchase a minimum of 300,000 gallons of propane per year
- CRSD was short of minimum by 90,829 gallons in 2022/2023
- Rhoads Energy will let us obtain the unused gallons in 2023/2024 to fulfill contract terms

Propane Contract Extension (continued)

- Once 2022/2023 contract terms are fulfilled, they will switch to 2023/2024 pricing
- Since we won't meet the minimum gallons in 2023/2024, we will extend contract into 2024/2025
- Lock in price morning of 8/17 School Board Meeting for minimum number of gallons we will need in 2024/2025 once the 2023/2024 contract minimum is met
- Durham has agreed to cover the difference between propane and diesel costs until the fleet is fully propane beginning in 2023/2024



Approve Physician Agreement

- Agreement was approved at July meeting with St Mary's Medical Center
- Agreement is with Langhorne Physician Services
- Revised agreement is much simpler and clearly states responsibility for malpractice insurance
- No cost to CRSD



Participate in the 2023/2024 School Breakfast Program

- Current State Budget includes State supplemented free breakfast for all but funding won't be available until budget impasse has ended.
- PDE mandates if you participate in the School Breakfast Program you must provide free breakfasts
- Should free breakfast for all be removed from signed budget we may have to cover the difference
- Similar program for free lunch for students who qualify for reduced lunch
- Should participate in the lunch program



2024/2025 Budget Update

- Met with Administrators group to go over plans for 2024/2025 budget
- Accelerate 2024/2025 budget process
- Mandatory changes
 - Use of a common budget worksheet
 - Budget entry to be made by staff in budget area
 - Budget entries to be made in detail
- Budget education to continue throughout the year
- Business Office Administrator and staff to provide help throughout process



2022/2023 Audit Engagement Letter

- Engagement letter for the 2022/2023 audit of the financial statements
- Engagement letter for the 2022/2023 agreed upon procedures for tax collections
- \$26,000 for the audit and \$3,500 for the AUP
- Total increase of \$1,500 over the prior year



Stop Loss Insurance Policy Renewal

- Used once a medical claim is over a certain threshold
- Current threshold is \$325,000
- Approached 7 carriers for quotes
 - O 2 declined to quote
 - O 4 were uncompetitive
 - O Highmark, who is our current carrier had the lowest quote and a better quote was negotiated
- Million-dollar claims have increased by 48% over the last 4 years
- New annual premium is \$1,377,851 with Highmark, which is an increase of \$386,718 or 39% over the prior year
- Paid from the Healthcare Fund
- Looked into increase in threshold to \$350,000, if using last years claims would have resulted in \$12,861 in additional costs
- Recommend leaving threshold at \$325,000



Policy 620 – Fund Balance

- Currently sets a minimum and maximum of 4% and 5% Unassigned Fund Balance of next years budgeted expenditures, respectively
- Would like to raise the maximum Unassigned Fund Balance to 8%
- Provides more protection in case of unexpected events
- Matches State maximum of 8% Unassigned Fund Balance
- Makes CRSD more comparable to other local districts
- Helps to protect our current bond rating
