Introduction:

CRSD is soliciting offers for the purchase, installation, setup, training, and technical support of a Student Assessment and Analytics System to meet the needs of the district. The basis of the RFP is to implement a system replacing our current PowerSchool PerformancePlus System that would allow for data-driven decision-making at multiple user and organization levels. The vendor should demonstrate expertise in the educational software development as well as proof of cyber/data security, SOCII security compliance and proof of cyber insurance. The request for proposal is for an integrated system to meet the immediate and long-range needs of CRSD as outlined in the general and detailed system requirements that follow. By integrated software package, we mean that all software delivered from a vendor should be facilitated from a common organization-wide database application permitting the total sharing of information within and across functions and other systems. The integration should include data access products such as those listed in "Systems Integration" below. By immediate and long range, CRSD means a system that will provide functionality to the school district for a period of 5-10 years with maintenance, upgrade, and support services available from the vendor. CRSD would like to move to the new system beginning with implementation starting the summer of 2023 and production no later than fall 2023.

In considering options for this software application, CRSD is most interested in exploring a software as a service (SAAS) system, focusing on the functional capabilities of the application. At the same time, integration and flexibility are key considerations, as CRSD continues to evaluate new options and consider redesigning processes to provide high-quality customer service as efficiently as possible. The application must work in support of, not as a hindrance to, innovation and serve the needs of CRSD both now and in the future.



Background

The Council Rock District covers 72 square miles and is comprised of five municipalities: Newtown Borough and the Townships of Newtown, Northampton, Upper Makefield, and Wrightstown. As of the 2010 census, the total population of the school district was approximately 73,110.

The task of educating approximately 10,700 students, K-12, is a large one and requires the increasing attention and devoted efforts of approximately 913 teachers and supervisors, as well as clerical, custodial, maintenance and cafeteria employees who support the instructional program in the fourteen schools. The school district is by far the largest employer in the area. The school district operates ten elementary schools (grades K-6), two middle schools (grades 7-8), and two high schools (grades 9-12). Council Rock is also one of four participating school districts in the Middle Bucks Area Vocational-Technical School located in Jamison, PA.

The district employs approximately 2650 total employees including substitute employees, approximately 840 of which are professional staff and 500 support services personnel. We intend to use the new system across the entire district of students.

- 1. How is your system best used for Special Services and Interventions?
- 2. Describe how your system supports the Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) and Professional Learning Communities (PLC) processes.
 - a. Assessment Development:
 - How does your system align to PA Common Core standards when developing assessments?
 - Does the system have a prepared question bank aligned to PA Common Core standards?
 - Can users create/import custom standards?
 - Does the assessment follow a 3-point or 4-point scale rubric?
 - Does the assessment provide for sub-score for each content area tested and partial scoring?
 - Can we import test templates from other programs? Provide examples.
 - Are multiple question types such as multiple-choice, short answer, essay, and formula builder available?
 - Does the system allow for test creation at specific levels, i.e., teacher, classroom, district?
 - Can assessments be shared, edited, copied, and distributed to other users?
 - Can assessments be available in multiple languages?
